

Approved Program Supplemental Endorsements For Teaching Coaching Concentration in the Department of Kinesiology

Instructions and Requirements:

- All courses for each licensure area require a grade of “C” or better.
- Application for the license should be sent or brought directly to the office of Clinical/Field-Based Instruction and Licensure OCFBI at MSU (309 Allen).
- OCFBI verifies coursework and grades and provides institutional verification if the applicant has met course/grade requirements.
- The application is returned to the applicant so that all licensure materials (including an official sealed transcript) can be submitted in one complete packet to the licensure office at Mississippi Department of Education (MDE). The applicant is responsible for mailing the packet to MDE.

Supplemental Endorsements:

The supplemental endorsements listed below can be added to a valid educator license by completing 21 hours with a prefix in the specific subject area. Coursework acceptable for these areas will be listed on the following page.

Courses with prefixes below may be counted toward a supplement endorsement in the areas listed.

English

Literature, English, Journalism (News writing, Editing)

Biology

Botany, Zoology, Biology, Microbiology, Human Anatomy and Physiology. Biochemistry

General Science

Geosciences

Any combination of semester hours with a science prefix (i.e., biology, chemistry, physics etc.)

Social Studies

History, Geography, Political Science, Economics, Sociology, Anthropology, Southern Studies, Government

Math

Coursework must have math prefix

Music

Coursework must have music prefix

Foreign Language

Coursework must have prefix of requested endorsement (Spanish, French, Latin, German, and Russian)
